TRADE ALLY ANNOUNCEMENT

Insulation and air sealing requirements: 40% of project cost up to \$375

- Insulation total must meet 2009 IECC recommended climate zone requirements. Includes attic and exterior wall insulation.
- Must provide info on Location, Type, Pre and Post R-values, square footage and total cost.
- If applicable, attic insulation and air sealing must be done. If they already meet requirements, rebate will cover floor/crawl space and/or wall.

Gas Furnace requirements: \$250

- Must be ENERGY STAR® certified
- Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) \geq 90%

General eligibility/application requirements are as follows:

- Must be signed up for the Denver Energy Challenge
- Must be a resident of the City and County of Denver
- Must provide an affidavit of residency
- Must provide a copy of photo ID
- An itemized contractor invoice is required
- Rebates are available for investments made between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2012
- Applications must be received within 120 days of the retrofit service date.
- Rebates are available first-come, first-served until funds are exhausted.
- Rebates will be issued only to complete, qualifying applications.

Rebate Applications - These will be available for download on the Recharge Colorado website no later than Feb. 1. Customers who have upgrades done between Jan. 1, 2012 and Dec. 31, 2012 will be eligible.

Xcel Rebates – Rebates through the Denver Energy Challenge can be used in combination with rebates also offered through Xcel. Please visit www.xcelenergy.com for more info.
